This **youth exchange** gathers teenagers of different backgrounds to make them aware about the school **bullying**, how to recognise and how to handle it in their position. To achieve this, they will attend **theatre workshops**, **conference**, **animation workshops** to obtain **tools**, **useful information** and **contacts**. Due to this, the participants are able to strengthen their capabilities to combat school bullying. They will realize communication tool (video) which be broadcast in the partner countries.

- To **gain knowledge and methods** to act against school bullying and to promote social inclusion
- To reflect on **initiatives** in the countries and schools of participants
- To create communication tool

Participants

France, Belgium, Italy and Germany



Each partner organisation should send a **leader** (over 18 years old) and **4 teenagers** between **15 and 17 years old** who are motivated to stand up against school bullying. In total, 20 participants of 4 different countries can take part in the youth exchange funded by the **Youth Erasmus + program**.

Practical information

Date : From the 2nd to the 22nd August 2021

Accommodation: The participants will be hosted in **'La Maison des Bateleurs'**, in Montendre (17130, France), a delegation of the French Mouvement **'Solidarités Jeunesses'**. It's a typical **regional house** renovated during an international workcamp. Since 1995 la Maison des Bateleurs has been a **hosting center** for international volunteers. The organisation welcomes around eight volunteers per year, so the participants will have the opportunity to participate in the **collective life** with the volunteers. The participants will be accommodated in two **dormitories** of eight people with bunk beds. There is a **common bathroom** with showers and toilets.
